### The Dogmas of the Catholic Church *5 of the 255 Infallibly Declared Dogmas*

221) The Sacrament of Penance is necessary for salvation to those who, after Baptism, fall into grievous sin.

222) The sole possessors of the Church's Power of Absolution are the bishops and priests.

223) Absolution given by deacons, clerics of lower rank, and laymen is not Sacramental Absolution.

224) The Sacrament of Penance can be received by any baptized person, who, after Baptism, has committed a grievous or venial sin.

225) The Church possesses the power to grant Indulgences.

## Pastor's Piece

**Dear Folks,**

Last Sunday I gave a little bit of homework ... to figure out which two miracles are recorded by all four Gospel writers. There was of course the multiplication of the loaves and fish to feed the five thousand. The other is the resurrection of our Lord Jesus on the third day. Some had guessed immediately after Mass that the second one was the miracle of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper. Saint John does not record this. Instead, he records what is known as the Bread of Life discourse which we are now going through for our Sunday Gospels. Using the missalettes or at home with your Bible, read chapter 6 of Saint John's Gospel to see how our Catholic understanding of the Holy Eucharist is the only interpretation that takes John 6 seriously.

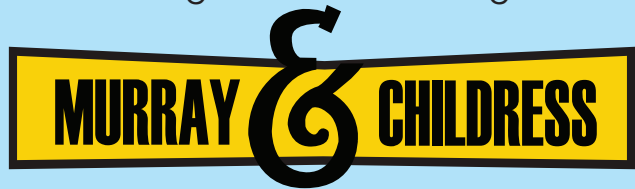

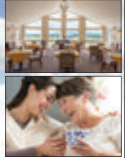
