May 7th is the first Saturday of the month. ### Diocesan Pilgrimage with Bishop Burbidge

On Saturday, June 25, 2022, Bishop Burbidge will be leading a pilgrimage to Philadelphia, PA, visiting the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter and Paul and Shrine of St. Katherine Drexel, the Shrine of St. John Neumann, and St. Charles Borromeo Seminary.

This pilgrimage is in preparation for our diocese's 50th anniversary, in 2024. This year, preparation is centered on the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and on the history of the founding of the Diocese. Our founding bishop and our current bishop were both rectors of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary, connecting our diocese's beginning with the present.

Bishop Burbidge will take a representative group of parishioners from across the Diocese, one from each parish or mission. These representatives will be "Pilgrimage Ambassadors" and selected by the Pastor.

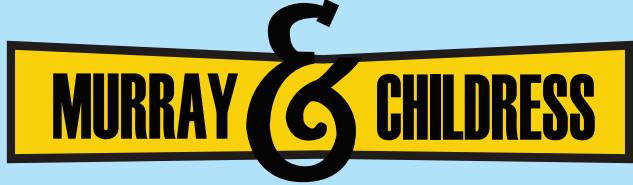
